

COACHING IN MINOR HOCKEY:

HOW TO APPLY FOR CLINICS

Contact NMHA office and make sure you have a Hockey ID number.

Once you have this, please go to www.bchockey.net, click on clinics

Respect in Sport, CATT, & Criminal record check must be done BEFORE helping with a team, that means, dressing rooms, on bench or on the ice.

Applying to attend clinics requires you to pay online, NMHA will reimburse the full amounts WITH RECIEPTS.

Team Positions & Requirements

Coach including Assistant Coach – must have Respect in Sport – Team Leader, Concussion Awareness Training(CATT), Coach level 1 or 2, & Criminal record Check(done yearly).

U9(formerly H1-H4) coaches must complete HU-online Coach 1/2 then register for the face to face clinic Coach 1

All other Recreational coaches must have **Coach 2**, if you have never done HU- online Coach 1/2 then complete that first.

Competitive Coaches must have Respect in Sport – Team Leader, Concussion Awareness Training(CATT), Coach Development 1 & Criminal record Check(done yearly).

Manager – must have Respect in Sport – Team Leader, Concussion Awareness Training(CATT), & Criminal record Check(done yearly).

Safety Person – must have Respect in Sport – Team Leader, Concussion Awareness Training(CATT) & Criminal record Check(done yearly) & HCSP, can be on bench at games but not help with coaching (ie opening doors), cannot help on ice at practice.
