

RETURNING PLAYER REGISTRATION 2024-25 BEGINS APRIL 5, 2024



VERY IMPORTANT: PLEASE READ ALL INFORMATION BELOW

Nanaimo Minor Hockey will be using the Hockey Canada Registry(HCR) for registration, registration will be completed from your Spordle account you set up last season. In the coming weeks, it would be beneficial for you to log in to your Spordle account and update any incomplete or missing information to help streamline the registration process. NEW Siblings may be registered at this time. Please send copy of Birth Certificate and Proof of residency to office.

One Parent per player must complete the **Parent Version** of Respect in Sport Program online (<u>click here</u>) select **Nanaimo Minor Hockey** for association. Only needs to be done once, so if you did it in the last few seasons you are good!

<u>Try out fees</u> are ONLY for those interested in our competitive program, at the U11, U13, U15, and U18, level. There is a NON-REFUNDABLE \$150.00 fee due at the time of registration. Please select Tryout Fee under OTHER items.

PAYMENT: Online credit card system will be available with cc fees being added to your final total. There are installment plans available with the online system.

All registrations fees must be paid in full by August 15, 2024. No exceptions, your player will be removed from the rosters until payment is completed.

If wishing to pay via etransfer, you can send etransfer to administrator@hockeynanaimo.com or you can phone in with cc, however there is a credit card fee payable, as well.

If paying offline a **Deposit of 25**% of your total must be paid within 5 business days of your registration or you forfeit your players spot within NMHA until paid. Balance must be paid by Aug. 15, 2024, again we will have wait lists, your player will lose their spot if this is not dealt with.

FEMALE DUAL REGISTRATIONS

Female players who wish to be on Female only teams and dual register to coed teams please register to Female Divisional and select **Dual Registration under OTHER items**, complete the Dual registration form and send to the office ASAP.

Female players who wish to be on Coed teams and dual register to Female teams please register to Coed Division and select **Dual Registration under OTHER items**, complete the Dual registration form, send to the office ASAP.

ALL Dual players will be on a wait list until teams are formed and Nanaimo MHA has ensured space is available for them on dual team selected. NOTE: that no male player will be denied a roster spot by virtue of the female player being dual rostered.

Transfer from Other Association: VIAHA TRANSFER FORM

The above link directs you to the form which must be included with ALL documentation in order to register with NMHA.

A Residential Move-with parent can only occur when a player resides within the NMHA boundaries as above, with his/her parent and the parent changes his/her permanent place of residence and the player continues to reside with his parent. This shall not be a temporary residence. The Registrar will request documents to support the move, depending on circumstances.
